

Kumon Summer Math Enrichment Frequently Asked Questions

General Registration and Program Info

Question: How can I register?

Answer: Please visit our LinkTree and simply fill out the attached Google Form for registration!

Question: What steps should I take after filling out the Google Form?

Answer: There are no further steps at this time. We will be in touch with you soon regarding payment. You can also call us at [\(410\) 721-9079](tel:4107219079) if you have any additional questions!

Question: When will the summer enrichment program be held?

Answer: 4 separate week-long summer sessions will be held. The program will run during the weeks of June 26th to June 30th, July 10th to July 14th, July 24th to July 28th, and August 7th to August 11th. Each session will run from Monday through Friday, from 9am to 3pm each day.

Question: What will students do in the summer enrichment program?

Answer: Students will work with trained math instructors to complete Kumon math material and reduce gaps in their math knowledge. The program intends to help students avoid the summer brain drain that commonly affects students when they take significant time away from schoolwork over the summer. This will help students advance their math knowledge and stay prepared for the coming school year.

Question: Will students get breaks during the summer enrichment, and will other learning activities be involved?

Answer: From 9 am to 12 pm, students will work in three 50-minute chunks, with each 50-minute working period followed by a 10-minute break period. From 12 pm to 1 pm, students will get a 1-hour lunch break where they will also be allowed to play board games, read books, or simply relax. From 1 pm to 3 pm, instructors will guide learning activities, including arts, crafts, or science-related projects, where students will also learn how to apply their math knowledge to the real world.

Question: My Child is not in grades 3-8. Can he/she still register?

Answer: Unfortunately, Kumon of Crofton is not accepting students outside of grades 3-8 for the summer enrichment program. However, these students are still welcome to join Kumon of Crofton's general learning program!

Question: Will lunch be provided?

Answer: From Monday through Thursday, students will be expected to pack their own lunch. On Friday, lunch will be provided. There is also a vending machine in the center which students are free to buy snacks from. An hour-long lunch break will be held from 12 pm to 1 pm each day of the summer program.

Payment

How much does Kumon of Crofton's Summer Enrichment Program cost?

Answer: For students already enrolled in Kumon, the first session you register for will cost \$300, with each additional session costing \$250. For students not already enrolled in Kumon, the first summer session you register for will cost \$325, with each additional session costing \$300. Additionally, there is a one-time \$50 registration fee, and a \$50 deposit per session to secure the student's spot in the program.

What is the purpose of the deposit?

This deposit will go towards the total tuition payment and is simply meant to secure the student's spot.

Question: Is the deposit refundable?

The deposit is 100% refundable if canceled by April 15th or 50% refundable if canceled by May 15th. There will be no refunds given after May 15th. The full tuition balance will be due May 16th, 2023.
